Personal Data Collected

The journal may collect and process:

Purpose of Processing

Data Sharing

Data may be shared where necessary:

- With service providers supporting journal operations
- Where required by law or regulatory authorities

All sharing is limited to what is necessary.

International Data Transfers

As an international journal, personal data may be processed in multiple jurisdictions.

Appropriate safeguards are applied to ensure data protection standards consistent with GDPR.

Data Security

Appropriate technical and organisational measures are applied to protect personal data against:

- Unauthorised access

- Loss or misuse
- Disclosure or alteration

Access is restricted to authorised personnel.

Data Retention

Personal data is retained only as long as necessary for:

- Maintenance of the scholarly record

Published articles and associated metadata remain permanently accessible.

User Rights
